The Pastor's Journal

The mystery of the Trinity tells us that God is a relationship of perfect unity. This means that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are three persons in one God.



This unity helps us see how God's relationship is reflected in

the readings. The Father creates, the Son saves, and the Holy Spirit guides us to all truth. This teaches us about living in harmony and sharing God's love.

In the Gospel, Jesus promises the Holy Spirit, who will guide us to all truth. This promise shows that God wants us to know and understand His will. The Holy Spirit is given to us to help us live according to God's plan.

The first reading speaks of Wisdom, present at the creation of the world. This Wisdom is a part of God's truth, showing us that truth has been with God from the beginning. The Holy Spirit, as the Spirit of Truth, continues to share this Wisdom with us. This helps us understand that living in truth is living in harmony with God.

Psalm 8 reminds us of God's relationship with the world. The Father created us, the Son revealed our true identity, and the Holy Spirit guides us in caring for creation. It calls us to honor God's name, reflect on our role as stewards, and live with gratitude for His love.

We are called to listen to the Holy Spirit and let Him guide our actions and decisions. By following the Spirit, we can live more faithfully and share God's truth with others. This reflection encourages us to be open to the Holy Spirit and to seek God's truth in all we do.

Understanding the Mass



The specific explanation of Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist is found in his words to us as we share the "Last Supper;" the "New Passover," with Jesus and the Apostles. In

Matthew 26:26-27 we read, "While they were eating, Jesus took the breadbroke it, and giving it to his disciples said, 'Take and eat; this **IS** my body.' Then he took the cup ... saying, 'Drink from it all of you, for this **IS** my blood of the covenant....''' (See also Mark 14:22-24 and Luke 22:19-20). We relive this event with Jesus at every Mass. He says these words through his priest regardless of when or where the Mass is celebrated. These are declarative statements of truth; not symbolic statements. Jesus did not back away from his teaching even when many disciples left him, and the Church has never backed down from accepting his teaching, regardless of how difficult the teaching is.
